PARKING AROUND SCHOOL AND CHILDREN'S CENTRE

Parking is still an issue – please use the large car park behind the Catholic Club and walk to the gate rather than parking on pavements or blocking access to other people.

LATE MARKS

We are becoming aware of an increasing number of children using the main entrance to access the school. Children must enter from their designated entry point at the allotted time. The gates are open for a slightly longer time to allow for late entries. All children coming to school through the main entrance must sign in using our electronic access system and will automatically be given a late mark even though their class register may not have been taken.

SCHOOL MEALS AND BREAKFAST CLUB PAYMENTS

Please ensure your account is in credit. Payment for Breakfast Club must be made in advance to secure your child's place.

The cost of a school meal will increase to $\pounds 2.15$ from September. Children's Centre meals will increase to $\pounds 2.26$ ($\pounds 2.15 + 5\%$ VAT)

Children in Y2 will not be eligible for universal free school meals when they move to Y3 in September. If your child currently has a school meal, you will automatically be charged. If you wish to change your child's meal pattern, you must complete a change to meal pattern form which is available on the website or a paper copy from the foyer at the main entrance.
