ENGLISH

In English we will be focusing on SATs preparation. We will be working on our test techniques, exploring SAT style questions and applying all of our learning from KS2. We will take time to look at SPaG and how we can answer SPaG questions. We will complete our SATs on the week beginning Monday 8^{th} May. We will sit the following papers on the days:

- Tuesday 9th May SPaG (two separate papers one 20 minute spelling and a 45 minute SPaG paper)
- Wednesday 10th May Reading (one paper with three different sections in 1 hour).

We will also be reading and working on the book "The boy at the back of the class" by Onjali Q. Raúf.

MATHS

In maths, we will begin by reviewing all question styles and methods. We will focus on ensuring all topics are covered and well-practiced before our SATs. We will complete our SATs on the week beginning Monday 8th May. We will sit the following papers on the days:

- Thursday 11th May Papers 1 and 2 (arithmetic for 30 minutes and then a 40-minute reasoning paper)
- Friday 12th May Paper 3 (reasoning paper for 40 minutes)

SCIENCE

In science, we will explore changes to materials in particular looking into reversible and irreversible changes - this will involve practical investigations and scientific observations!

PSHE/BRITISH VALUES

In health and wellbeing, we'll be starting the term by attending workshops on 'Give racism the red card.' This opportunity will help pupils develop their understanding on issues like racism, discrimination and prejudice.

YEAR 6 SUMMER 1 CURRICULUM

COMPUTING

This half-term we will complete our Text Adventure Stories from last half-term, then move on to exploring the difference between the World Wide Web and Internet. We will also get a chance to see how the school's network runs and conduct some research into the inventor of the World Wide Web: Tim Berners-Lee.

HISTORY

In our history topic, will answering the question 'How have the rights of children changed over time?' this will involve the pupils learning all about the UNCRC. We will explore how children have the right to education and how this has changed over time.

PE

In PE, we will be using the Core Task of Pairs Cricket to further work on our skills associated with games and in particular, batting and fielding games.

We're also lucky enough to have Commando Joe on a Friday afternoon this Term to help with teambuilding and cooperation skills further too.

<u>RE</u>

We will be exploring why is Moses important to Jewish people. This will include an exploration into the Jewish religion and who Moses was.

MUSIC

We will be expanding our knowledge of notation and musical compositions. We will look at written music, appreciate music and discuss what we have learnt and listened to.

DT

We will be learning about 'Funky Furnishings' with the aim of children designing and making their own cushion cover. We will learn and apply sewing skills to decorate and join fabric to make our cushions.

FRENCH

This term our French will explore our conversational skills as we plan and prepare conversations about family, home, holiday, clothes and much more. We will focus on the verb 'aller' meaning to go.
